Light turnout cattle at both barns selling off the premiums we have seen in past weeks, virtually even with the feeder weight cattle as most feedlots prefer the heavier cattle. Feeder cattle showing excellent demand and selling at some all time highs. Butcher cows are trying to break out to new highs and look as they should moving closer to Spring and as we get the extra dairy beef cleaned up and off the shelf. Bred cows and pairs no good test, showing good but slightly lower demand. Look for this to take a good bounce as soon as we get some good moisture!
