The market over the past few weeks has grabbed another gear and has made some new historical highs. We are seeing most all weight classes sell very well and they are in extremely high demand! The very light cattle may be called the soft spot as we now transition into the fall calf crop and local grass demand has died down. This weight class is now just too young for most feedlots and out-of-state grass buyers to handle, although still bringing some phenomenal prices. Most of the demand on the new crop calves is coming on one weighing over 425-450. It will pay you to make them weigh over that but keep in mind that demand also slows to some degree when you get up over 750 on a calf, with a yearling of this weight showing very good demand on the other hand. We have just begun the spring run of calves and yearlings and it looks to be a record setting marketing season with buyers from multiple states already showing up as it does seem as though there will be extremely high demand especially for the better quality cattle. Look for this demand to stay strong all the way through the spring and at least the early summer! We have several good marketing opportunities coming up this month and into the first part of June. If you are unsure as to what week will fit you best, please don't hesitate to call. I am very confident that each week from now until the middle of summer will prove to have very active buyer participation from a multitude of buyers across the country. As always the better the quality and the better the shot program, the more buyer demand you will see.

Butcher cows also another great market! We have watched the cows get stronger each week with demand picking up even more over the past two weeks. Look for this to also stay strong right along.

Last Saturday was our annual bred cow and pair sale. There was a great offering of high-quality females, and they were met with strong demand as one would expect. The very fancy coming three year olds with all the right stuff, including foothill and anaplaz vaccinations sold at the top of the range from \$3050 to \$3400 consistently with the top set at \$3650. The high end 3-4 yr old rebreed cows with the vaccinations selling from \$2500 to \$3100 and the high end re-breeds with no foothill or anaplaz vaccination selling at \$1950-\$2350 depending on age and quality. Fall pairs bred back in a limited offering \$3850 and spring pairs \$2000-\$2700. All in all it was a great sale and was well attended from many prospective buyers. Don't miss our June 24 Annual Fall Calving Cow Sale. This will be another great offering of Females. Many with all the right vaccinations!!
