The market over the past few weeks has been at the upper end of the current range for most of the time. We did see some small pull backs in select spots from week to week, as well as some significant upticks on certain classes at times. The slight ups and downs would either be a result of the current temperature of the futures market or more often a result of cattle quality and conditions or buyer needs. The Strong price trend has remained mostly consistent on all classes of stockers and feeders right along over the past several months, with the price gaps being wider and more prevalent on the grass weight cattle. Butcher cows and bulls also following the same trend with some slight ups and downs in spots, but spending the bulk of the time at the top end of their range. The spring marketing season is quickly approaching, and it is time to start that process. Boosting should be top of mind, and it is time to schedule that in as it is becoming evident that it will most likely be a very early spring and summer, it already does feel like April now. The grass sure is high in quality and the cattle look great in most all locations. But I am certain we can plan on it drying up fast when it decides to turn. As for the coming marketing season, we do look for the prices to stay at the upper end of the range and it will certainly be the most we have sold them for in this marketing period! We all should look forward to a fun run this year with some exciting prices ahead!!
