The market has performed very well over the last month or so! We are seeing some record prices in spots on the fancier end of most all grass weight classes. Good amounts of rain and warm winter temps in most spots have stocker operators chasing inventory. Although we have seen some records broken on the high end, we do have to note that the price gaps from the bottom end to the top end is now wider than ever. Quality, condition, and vaccinations will be the driving force when it comes to prices attained. Also, not all cattle are created equal and not all people see them the same as this can play a role at times also. With that said we would call the stocker weight cattle higher across-the-board. Feeder weight Cattle called steady to a tick cheaper in some spots. Butcher cows and bulls also called steady with good demand out there, especially on the higher yielding better end!

We do want to stress that 2 rounds of the proper vaccines will be of the utmost importance to the biggest majority of calf buyers for this upcoming spring marketing season. As always if you are unsure what is needed please give us a call. We would caution that not all pharmaceutical reps or even vets for that matter are up on all the vaccines that the industry wants. Please be sure that you cover all the bases to help ensure that your cattle sell at the upper end of the price range!

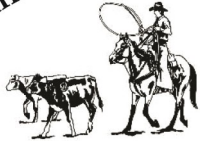
