The last three weeks have continued to show us just how strong this cattle market really is. We have worked through the later part of the spring run and into the early summer cattle, and the demand has stayed very good on the right kind. We are still seeing a big spread in the market from the top to the bottom, and that spread is not going away. The cattle with quality, condition, reputation, shots, weaning information and weighing conditions are still bringing very impressive dollars. The cattle that are missing some of those pieces are where we continue to see the larger discounts. The very best steers and heifers are still selling at the top end of the range, especially the bigger strings of good quality cattle with the proper vaccination program in place. The market is very strong, but the buyers are sorting harder than ever. At these record-type price levels and this time of year, the details matter. The buyers know what kind of cattle will work, and they are willing to step up on the ones that check all the boxes. The heifer market continues to be very quality-driven. The true replacement kind of heifer is still very well received, and the better feeder heifers are still bringing very good money. The plainer heifers or the heifers that do not have the same kind of future are still selling at a discount to the steers, which is to be expected. As we have said before, there is a reason the very best steer calves are such a sought-after commodity, and there is also a reason the true replacement-quality heifers can bring right up there with them when the right kind is offered.

Butcher cows and bulls have also remained very strong. The good high-yielding cows and bulls continue to see excellent demand, and the feeder cows and young cows are still bringing very good dollars when they have some future use to them. Once again, there is a big spread from the high-yielding, attractive cows to the lower-yielding or plainer cows, but the top end is still bringing record prices.

We also want to talk about our Annual Fall Calving Female Sale, because it was truly one of the outstanding female offerings we have had the opportunity to sell. The quality was exceptional, and the top end of those cattle proved just how much demand there is for premium replacement females. You cannot just go anywhere and buy that quality of females. These are the kind of females that take years of breeding, selection, management and reputation to put together. The Red Angus three-year-old bred heifers that topped the sale were a special commodity. They were the kind that do not come along every day, and we are fortunate to be able to produce and offer a sale with that level of quality. The demand on the best bred heifers was outstanding, with the top Red Angus bred heifers bringing up to \$6700 per head and several of the front-end black and red bred heifers selling from \$6000 to \$6700. The better bred cows and front-end replacement females were also very well received, proving again that quality females are still very hard to find and very much in demand. We would also like to give a special thank you to the California Angus Association for providing the outstanding New York steaks for the BBQ lunch. We appreciate their support and their continued involvement in the cattle industry. It made for a great day, and we were proud to have such a strong group of consignors, buyers and cattlemen here at VLM.

We feel very fortunate to be selling cattle in this kind of market, but we also want to remind everyone that the market is rewarding the cattle that are managed right. Vaccination records, weaning information, good sorting, reputation and condition are making a tremendous difference. Please remember to fill out your vaccination records when you bring calves in to sell so we can get that information to the buyers and help your cattle bring all they are worth.
