The market over the past two weeks called firm again. This thing has held together well this far and we have not seen much change in demand and prices. Although we have seen extreme light calves come off and sell cheaper with decreased demand, all other weight classes called steady/firm with the bigger weights selling higher last week on 650 pounds to 950 pounds. We do look for demand to decrease somewhat as the number of offerings gets smaller and the weather heats up around the country. With that said there should not be a drastic decrease in price on the higher quality cattle with all the proper shots! We would caution that the big world picture could throw us a curveball, let's hope not we will see.

Beef should be in a good spot with cow numbers decreasing and the inventory situation being friendly for the market moving forward! Butcher cows have stayed strong all spring with a \$10 range from week to week. But we have now seen the cow market slip a bit more over the past two weeks selling down at some new recent lows coming off another \$10. We are now selling better cows in the \$75-\$85 range this past week. We do look for this to be the low end of the new range at least until we see a big inflow of dairy cows once the summer weather sets in. Don't miss our annual fall Calving Female sale Saturday, June 18 at 12 o'clock this will be another great offering of females.
