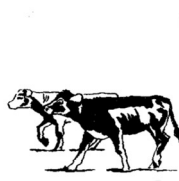

The Market over the past three sales here at VLM has remained fully steady on most all classes. As we noted in our last report, the market had reached some new all-time highs yet again! We are seeing most buyers staying with it up to this point, although it does feel that moving forward we will see slightly decreased participation on some classes. As we do call the market steady at this point, we are starting to see some soft spots on certain classes. The light Cattle with all the right stuff continue to sell at the upper end of the range, with some of the lesser quality, overly fleshy or limited vaccination Cattle seeing softer prices and selling with some decreased demand at times. The feeder weight cattle also following the same trend with the better fully vaccinated Cattle selling mostly steady. We are starting to see some decreased demand on the others, although the price drops on these weight classes are not as much as the lighter ones.

Butcher cows did pick up some added demand this past week or two and jumped back to the upper end of the range on all classes with the medium and lower yielding cows picking up some added demand. This mostly due to an increased appetite for the feeder types from a variety of buyers. We do look for cows to stay relatively strong for now! Bred cows, as has been the case right along continue to sell extremely well on the better quality young females. Don't miss this next Saturday, June 21st our annual fall calving female sale as this will be another great offering of young fall females!! As always any questions please call anytime. 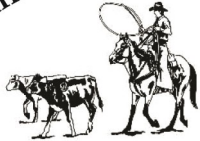
