The market this past couple weeks has been trying to gain strength. We did see good numbers last week and most all classes called mostly five dollars higher on the better quality cattle. This week's offering was somewhat limited on bunches and called slightly cheaper overall. This was not a good test as the market does have a better more positive feel to it. We would expect things to keep gaining traction and keep the upward momentum. The much-needed first rain did come in a good amount across the state especially the northern half. This has helped the light cattle, which was much needed. Expect this to continue upward as we get more rain! Feeder cattle also showing some added life but called just mostly steady as they were not as discounted as the lighter cattle. A recently improving cash market in the fat cattle which has been stagnant in the very low 120s has finally broke out and it did catch up to the futures just over 130 which has feeders smiling finally. Look for the feeder market to stay strong or even improve as long as cash stays solid.

Butcher cows which have been a joke for multiple weeks did finally also improve putting on a solid five to \$10 the past couple of weeks. As stated before this bears watching from week to week we will still have our ups and downs depending how many cows are on the market and who needs some at the time. We don't look for serious improvement until after the first of the year as is the norm. Although we could be ahead of schedule if more cows came early because of drought. Bred cows and pairs no real good test except a few nice pairs which sold well. There is still some demand around for the better quality bred cows and pairs! If you need last-minute bulls we do still have some avenues to get them for you.

Also branding season is near and we cannot impress it enough. There are now huge price discounts for improperly vaccinated cattle in our market today. This will continue to be the case from now on and should be a big incentive for everyone to do it correctly. We are still getting all kinds of various shot combinations. It must be the right stuff or you are wasting your time! Any questions *Please Please* feel free to give me a call.
