The market over the past two weeks has been just a bit spotty. Most all the cattle with all the right stuff still selling well with slightly decrease demand but still staying in the upper end of the range. Plainer and off cattle or cattle with limited shots now seeing bigger discounts than in previous weeks. We are in that time of year when most buyers are more particular and this is adding pressure to most all classes except the very front end. Look for this to level out some on the lighter cattle as we get rain! Quality, shots and breed choice are for sure more of a difference maker than in the past or in history I suppose. These have become front line issues for most all buyers these days, but it seems that it is sometimes subjective and buyer specific for the most part and at times is not consistent with different opinions. This is the world we live in especially in the fall when there are a lot of cattle moving in most of the country. Rest assured though if you do strive to do everything correct you will be paid for it. Any questions as to what is trending and going on in the market place please don't hesitate to call anytime.

Butcher cows seeing the normal fall discounts also although it is cheaper it certainly is holding together better than the past few falls. Look for this to be the trend through the end of the year and then move higher and be good this spring. Cattle inventory is down and not showing signs of rebuilding now. Look for prices to be good ahead, but we will always have some form of headwinds to watch out for. All we need for now is rain and then plan out your bull power and vaccinations at branding time to be sure you were on the right path for success. Again any questions please don't hesitate to call. Also don't miss November 16th and December 7th if you have needs for pairs or bred cows. There will be a decent offering both those weeks. Again if you have last minute bull needs give me a call, we do know where there are still some pretty good bulls.
