

The market this past Wednesday may have reached a high watermark! We watched this market be nothing short of extraordinary for sometime. This past month and a half has marked another sharp rally seemingly making new highs every day or two on the stocker and feeder cattle. The Live cattle and Feeder Futures this week made new all-time highs on Wednesday before going limit down on Friday following the White House announcement that they were going to try to lower the beef prices. Most stocker and feeder operators as well as Packers have been in a get mode to this point and this last Wednesday we saw some record prices in both stocker and feeder cattle with three weights well over the six dollar mark, and four weights in the low to mid five dollar range. One would think that this could be a top for at least the near term as this announcement did not have much detail but will make the market trade on the defensive for now. We will trade the speculation to some degree but at the end of the day our fundamentals are still positive and should prevail and at least keep us near the top of the range. We do know that as we add beef to the pipeline this market will trend lower, but this is not going to happen overnight.

Look for cows to be slightly softer moving forward, but still trade near the top of the range also. There are still a good number of cattle hitting the market and a large number of buyers meeting them with robust demand. Look for the higher quality bred cows, and pairs to still show good demand and sell near the highs.
